

Tsiridis Frimley Orthopaedic Travelling Fellowship

One Year fixed term contract available from August 2018

This one-year Fellowship is designed to provide skills and competencies above and beyond what is currently required to obtain a CCT in Trauma & Orthopaedics. It affords an excellent training opportunity in the whole spectrum of modern Orthopaedic surgery. We have 27 consultants offering a wide range of exposure to Hip & Knee, Foot & Ankle, Hand, Shoulder & Elbow, and Spinal Surgery, with the opportunity to train in more complex procedures including cervical surgery, hip arthroscopy, hind foot reconstruction, patellofemoral surgery, revision arthroplasty, endoprosthetics and periprosthetic fracture management.

The programme has been designed to include regular supervised elective and trauma clinics and operating theatre sessions. It is supported by educational meetings and relevant research. The timetable is predominantly supervised, but there is some opportunity for independent operating dependant on level of experience.

The post is at Registrar (middle grade) level to provide care for patients for a designated Consultant team, and support more junior doctors. The successful candidate will receive the same support & educational opportunities as national trainees. The job is for 12 months extendable to two years if both parties are in agreement, and the successful candidate would be able to rotate 6 monthly through different specialties including Hip & Knee, Foot & Ankle, Hand, Shoulder & Elbow, and Spinal Surgery.

Applicants must have full GMC Registration, and CCT or equivalent.
